### Lao Beijing

The decor (complete with wooden stools and mood lighting) is a little kitsch, prompting flashbacks to 'Crouching Tiger, Hidden Dragon', but the menu is faultless. The roast Peking duck is a standout, the skin crisp and the doughy wraps just-so.
